

Teacher Action Plan

Simple Steps to help you create a Positive School

1. Share our Web site (www.PositiveSchool.com) with your principal and school leadership team.
2. Encourage your principal, leadership team and fellow teachers to read the *Positive School Manifesto*. This can be downloaded for free at www.PositiveSchool.com.
3. Invite your principal on the bus and suggest that he/she read a copy of *The Energy Bus: 10 Rules to Fuel your Life, Work and Team with Positive Energy* and *The No Complaining Rule: Positive Ways to Deal with Negativity at Work*.
4. Once your principal and leadership team understand the process and principles necessary to create a Positive School then they will want to share these concepts with their teachers and students and empower them to take action.
5.
